

On Friday, February 9, 2018, Night to Shine, an unforgettable prom night experience centered on God's love, for people with special needs, ages 16 and up, will take place at more than 350 churches around the world simultaneously. Royal Redeemer Lutheran Church is blessed to be a host church. The following volunteer teams are necessary to make this a memorable night for our guests. We need 250 volunteers (**175 of which will comprise the buddy team**)

- **ALTERATION TEAM**

Will work with our guests and our dress team to take measurements, and prepare their outfits in advance for the big night. Sewing skills are needed.

- **BATHROOM ATTENDANT TEAM**

Man our restrooms or changing rooms and offer assistance in the restroom changing area as needed.

- **BEAUTY TEAM**

Beauticians/Barbers, Make-up Artists, Skin Care, Manicurists, and Massage Therapists
This team helps with hair/make up pre-prom, and offers touch ups at prom to make sure guests look their best as they make their trip down the red carpet and are photographed by the paparazzi. Skin care, massage, manicures, beauticians/barbers, and make-up teams will also be available in our caregiver rooms to help pamper our caregivers.

- **BUDDY TEAM**

Every attender will be assigned a buddy for the evening. Buddies hang out with guests, make conversation while enjoying dancing, food, and karaoke alongside guests. Buddies are to assist guests for the evening while encouraging guests to participate in the fun following the guest's desires.

- **CAREGIVER TEAM**

Caregivers will be Spoiled as they are treated to dinner, music, coffee and relaxation.

- **COAT CHECK TEAM**

Greet our guests with a friendly face and organize guest's coats. As guests leave, ask for their names and retrieve their coats.

- **CROWN/TIARA TEAM**

Display and distribute crowns and tiaras for every guest because every guest is a king or queen.

- **DECORATING TEAM**

This team will help us to transform the ballroom, lobby and break off rooms at the Holiday Inn Strongsville into a magical setting

- **DOORMAN TEAM**

Greet our guests and caregivers at the door and lend a hand where is needed. Show them to the Coat Check area, and answer questions.

- **DRESS TEAM**
We're assisting guests ahead of time in finding the right outfit to wear. This team will keep guests looking sharp by organizing a dress drive by collecting formal dresses and helping to organize the dress boutique to be held at Royal Redeemer
- **FLOWER TEAM**
Assist the florist with assembling corsages and boutonnieres, and to help with unloading and properly laying out. Help guests put on their flower. They will also be responsible for flowers for certain volunteer teams.
- **KARAOKE TEAM**
Help guests choose songs to sing, help run the karaoke machine, and be a part of cheering each singer. Some guests may prefer to sing with a member of the Karaoke Team and we encourage you to do so!
- **LIMO TEAM**
Coordinates the donation of limos and offers short limo rides around the parking lot during the event. You'll assist guests getting in and out of their vehicles as well as engage any guests that may be waiting for their limo ride.
- **MEDICAL TEAM**
Assist by providing basic first aid and care for any medical needs or emergencies. You'll also be available to direct guests to EMT's or report disturbances. Doctors, nurses, EMT's.
- **PARKING LOT TEAM**
Directs parking lot traffic and assist guests getting in and out of their cars. Assist drivers and guests with weather related conditions (ex: scraping snow covered windshields)
- **PAPARAZZI TEAM**
Give our guests the red carpet treatment as they're met with a mob of friendly "pretend" photographers as they enter the event. The main goal is to take photographs and treat participants like honored guests and celebrities.
- **PHOTO TEAM**
This team will be responsible for capturing moments of our guests and caregivers throughout the night.
- **REGISTRATION TEAM/ VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN TEAM**
Warmly greet guests and volunteers, sign them in, and to answer any questions.
- **SECURITY TEAM**
As part of the Security team, your job will be to assist security personnel during the event. This team will walk around and monitor all venues, and will make **sure exits are** not blocked and all areas remain wheel chair accessible.
- **SHOE SHINE STATION TEAM**
Give our guests the royal treatment with a shoe shine while engaging guests in conversation. This team will help set up and tear down the shoe shine station.
