*Isaiah 43:18-19a*

Isaiah 43:18-19a...“Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing!

1. New Years Day (and every day) is a good time to hit the reset button, be renewed, get a \_\_\_\_\_, and make needed adjustments. (Ephesians 4:23-24)
  
2. God \_\_\_\_\_ you intimately...and He \_\_\_\_\_ you unconditionally!
  - God hand \_\_\_\_\_ you! (Psalm 139:13-16)
  - He \_\_\_\_\_ you in spite of you! (John 3:16)
  - He has \_\_\_\_\_ for you! (Jeremiah 29:11)
  
3. What can we do to be in \_\_\_\_\_ with God’s plans for us?
  - Hit the \_\_\_\_\_ button on the past. (Isaiah 43:18-19a)
