**“Breaking Sins’ Grip”**  
*Replace Betrayal with Faithfulness*  
Luke 22:1-6

I. Jesus remained faithful to \_\_\_\_\_ and the \_\_\_\_\_ even after Judas betrayed Him.

John 18:11

Jesus commanded Peter, “Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given me?”
