SERMON OUTLINE BLESSED - *The Blessing of Being Gentle*

Matthew 5:5

I. Meek means
Matthew 11:29 KJV Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart.
II. It is to be gentle
James 3:13 NASB Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom.
III. Gentleness springs from
Colossians 3:12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
IV. Gentleness is rooted in
Ephesians 4:2 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.
V. Gentleness can as a witness
Phil 4:2a Let your gentleness be evident to all.
VI. It was a gentle Jesus who
I Peter 2:23 When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly.

Next Steps:

- 1. Remember what gentleness is not. It does not bully, it is not abrasive, harsh, course or savage.
- Ask God to give you the compassion and humility that are at the root of gentleness.
